How to Join In Representing Your Community:

If you are a current resident in the housing sites owned and managed by Boulder Housing Partners and at least 18 years of age, you qualify to join as an elected member of the Resident Representative Council (RRC).

Duties as a RRC Representative:

- Representatives serve for a term of two years .
- Attend monthly meetings on the second Wednesday of the month, September through May.
- Listen and talk with other residents in your neighborhood about issues which are submitted to monthly council meetings.
- Distribute RRC information to your respective site.
- Provide your name, address and phone number to residents as a contact for your site.
- Attend RRC sponsored seminars and training sessions.
